We have many types of volunteering opportunities to suit your interests and availability, and we strive to make volunteering fun and rewarding! Below are the specific volunteering opportunities we currently have available.

Secretary (Executive Board Member) Get to know the Education Foundation (EF) from the ground up by volunteering as the Secretary. In partnership with the Education Foundation's President, manage the administration of the Education Foundation. Attend monthly board meetings and a half-day annual retreat. Time Commitment: 0.5 to 3 hours per week
